## **Annual Report — Academic Year 2024-2025**

### **Little Flower Higher Secondary School, Gairatganj**

The academic session of 2024-2025 commenced on 1st April 2024 with renewed energy and enthusiasm. On 12th April, the school conducted the cabinet election to select student leaders. A memorable celebration was held on 24th April to mark the birthday of our Manager, followed by the beginning of summer vacation from the same day.

The CBSE Board Exam results were declared on 13th May, where 50 students successfully passed. The highest score was an impressive 92.16%. During this period, Sr. Sophia, the principal, was transferred, and Sr. Shine took charge as the new principal. Sr. Teresa was also transferred, and Sr. Sophia assumed responsibility as the KG Incharge.

Teachers reported back to school on 12<sup>th</sup> June, and from 13th to 14th June, a teacher training session was conducted. A staff meeting followed on 14th June. After the summer break, the school reopened on 18<sup>th</sup> June.

On 20th June, the school celebrated International Yoga Day with participation from all classes. A POCSO Committee meeting was held on 24th June. The school also launched extracurricular activities such as dance, yoga, band, and karate.

On 18th July, a meeting for the Sexual Harassment Committee was held. The Investiture Ceremony was conducted with great honor, and Mr. Mahesh Tandedkar (TI, Gairatganj) served as the Chief Guest. The school also introduced a new teaching- learning method in collaboration with Wexl Company. On 15th July, the school celebrated Manager's Day. The school remained closed on 17th July in observance of Muharram. On 20th July, the vibrant Guru Purnima celebration was held, and the principal also attended the Bhopal Sahodaya meeting. Periodical Assessment | (PA1) for classes 1 to 10 began on 22nd July, and the results were announced on 10th August. On 13<sup>th</sup> August, teachers and students participated in A 'Har Ghar Tiranga' rally in Gairatganj town. The Independence Day was celebrated with great patriotism; Mr. Mahesh Singh hoisted the national flag, and a parade and cultural presentations followed.

On 17th August, the Grandparents' Day was celebrated by KG students. The same day, a Rakhi-making competition was held in honor of Raksha Bandhan. On 26th August, Janmashtami was celebrated with color and devotion. The quarterly examination for KG students began on 27th August. On 5th September, the school celebrated Teachers' Day. On 14th September, the KG results were declared. The school remained closed on 16th September in observance of Eid-e-Milad.

The Mid-term Examination began on 18th September and continued till the October. 2nd October, Gandhi Jayanti, was observed as a holiday. On 5th October, Yellow Day was celebrated in Class 10. The List of Candidates (LOC) was submitted on 10th October. Students participated in inter-school sports competitions, including Kho-Kho and Cricket. Mid-term results were announced on 26<sup>th</sup> October. On 27th October, students participated in Diya making, drawing, and essay competitions for Diwali.

The jubilee celebration of our principal, Sr. Shine, was held on 28th October. Diwali holidays were scheduled from 29th October to 3<sup>rd</sup> November. From 4th November, various sports competitions were held. On 10th November, a one-day picnic was organized for Classes 4 to 7. The school remained closed on 15<sup>th</sup> November for Guru Nanak Jayanti. On 16<sup>th</sup> November, Classes 8 to 10 went on a picnic to Pachmarhi. TD vaccination for Class 5 students was done on 21st November.

On 29th November, the school hosted an exhibition showcasing talents in science, art, language, social science, and computers. The NAS examination for Class 9 was conducted on 14th December. The first Pre-Board Examination started on 9th December. The Christmas celebration was held on 21<sup>st</sup> December, and winter vacation began on 28th December. The school reopened on 6<sup>th</sup> January.

The second Pre-Board Examination began on 13th January, and the school celebrated YogaDay the same day. Staff and students visited Sevadham Ashram, Pura, and distributed food and stationery as a gesture of charity. Our school was honored with an award from the Regional Office in recognition of ensuring safety and security. On 26th January, the school celebrated Republic Day and students also performed at the block-level event. An inspection by the BRC took place on 7th February for renewal recognition of Classes 1 to 8.
